(Approved by His Honour the Lieutenant Governor in Council dated 2 September 2003.)

**WILDLIFE CONSERVATION ACT  
HUNTING AND TRAPPING REGULATIONS  
AMENDMENT**

(Approved by His Honour the Lieutenant Governor in Council dated 2 September 2003.)

Pursuant to section 28 of the *Wildlife Conservation Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. W-4.1, Council made the following regulations:

**1. The title to the Hunting and Trapping Regulations (EC330/99) is amended by the addition of the word "SEASONS" after the word "TRAPPING".**

**2. Schedules I and II are revoked and the following substituted:**
