#### DAIRY FARMERS OF PRINCE EDWARD ISLAND

ORDER. **DFPEI 2005-07 EFFECTIVE: 1 August 2005** 

Under the Dairy Farmers of Prince Edward Island Regulations and under the Natural Products Marketing Act, R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. N-3, Dairy Farmers of Prince Edward Island makes the following Order:

#### LEVIES ORDER

Application

1. This Order provides for the establishment, control and regulation of levies on butterfat delivered by milk and cream producers during the period 1 August 2005 - 30 November 2005.

Definitions

2. The words herein shall have the meanings as found in the Natural Products Marketing Act and the Dairy Farmers of Prince Edward Island regulations.

Milk producer levies

- 3. (a) Each producer who delivers milk in Prince Edward Island shall pay to the Board a levy of \$0.1284 per kilogram of butterfat on all milk delivered by him for general administration of the Board.
- (b) Each producer who delivers milk in Prince Edward Island shall pay to the Board a levy of \$0.2837 per kilogram of butterfat on all milk delivered by him for product promotion.

Within quota levies: cream producers

4. Each cream producer who delivers farm separated cream to a plant in Prince Edward Island shall pay to the Board a levy of \$0.095 per kilogram of butterfat delivered by him that is within the Quota fixed and allotted to him. This levy includes \$0.04 per kilogram of butterfat for general administration of the Board and \$0.055 per kilogram of butterfat for product promotion.

Over quota levies: cream producers

5. Each producer who delivers farm separated cream in excess of the Quota fixed and allotted to him shall pay to the Board a levy of \$4.405 per kilogram of butterfat that is in excess of the Quota fixed and allotted to him. This levy includes \$4.31 per kilogram of butterfat for disposal of surplus product, \$0.04 per kilogram of butterfat for general administration of the Board and \$0.055 per kilogram of butterfat for product promotion.

Revocation

6. Dairy Farmers of Prince Edward Island Order # 2004-04, dated the 1st day of December 2004, is hereby revoked.

Commencement

7. This Order comes into force 1 August 2005.

#### PRINCE EDWARD ISLAND POTATO BOARD

UNDER the <u>Natural Products Marketing Act</u>, R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap.N-3, the Prince Edward Island Potato Marketing Plan Regulations, and the <u>Agricultural Products Marketing Act</u> (Canada), the Prince Edward Island Potato Board makes the following order:

#### **Dealer Licensing Order**

Application

1. This order applies to the control and regulation of potato dealers in Prince Edward Island

Definitions

- In this order
  - (a) "Act" means the Natural Products Marketing Act R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. N-3;
  - (b) "Board" means the Prince Edward Island Potato Board established pursuant to the Act;
  - (c) "Consumer" means a person who purchases potatoes for personal consumption by that person or his family;
  - (d) "Dealer" means a person who, on his own behalf or as an agent for or on behalf of any other person, is engaged in the marketing of potatoes in Canada and the United States, including Puerto Rico;
  - (e) "Dispute Resolution Corporation" means the Fruit and Vegetable Dispute Resolution Corporation established in 1999 pursuant to Article 707 of the North American Free Trade Agreement;
  - (f) "Plan" means any plan established for the marketing of potatoes established and amended from time to time pursuant to the Act;
  - (g) "potatoes" means potatoes produced in the Province of Prince Edward Island;
  - (h) "producer" means a person who, in Prince Edward Island, grows potatoes on his own land or on land owned by others; and
  - "transfer" includes any sale of shares of a corporation which results in a change of control of the corporation.

Licensing

- 3.(1) No dealer shall engage in the marketing of potatoes without a license from the
  - (2) Subsection 3.(1) does not apply to any producer who sells his own potatoes directly to a consumer in Prince Edward Island.

Fees

4. The license fee payable to the Board by all dealers engaged in the marketing of potatoes shall be \$ 1,400 plus applicable taxes annually and such license shall be issued to a dealer only on the dealer agreeing to the terms and conditions as set forth in the application for the license.

### Collection and remittance of levies

- 5.(1) Each dealer engaged in the marketing of potatoes in Prince Edward Island shall pay a charge to the Board of three cents per hundredweight for potatoes shipped by the dealer based on each transportation number issued by the Board. In addition, each dealer shall collect and remit to the Board the prescribed producer levies for such shipments as set out in Board Order 04-1 (Levies Order).
- (2) For potatoes planted in the year 2005 only, the levies payable pursuant to section 5.(1) shall be six cents (\$0.06) per hundredweight.

### Application deadline

- 6.(1) Applications for dealer licenses must be received by the Board by no later than July 31st of each year.
  - (2) Notwithstanding sub-section 6(1), the application deadline for the 2005/06 marketing season shall be August 12, 2005.

#### License issuance 7.(1)

- 7.(1) Licenses shall be issued by the Board annually on August 1<sup>st</sup> of each year.
  - (2) Notwithstanding sub-section 7(1), licenses for the 2005/06 marketing season shall be issued by the Board on August 15, 2005.
  - (3) No person who was not a licensed dealer for the 2004/05 marketing season shall be issued a license for the 2005/06 marketing season or any subsequent seasons.
  - (4) No person shall be issued a license unless that person is a member in good standing in the Dispute Resolution Corporation, and the license of that person shall be suspended immediately by the Board if the person's membership in the Dispute Resolution Corporation is suspended, cancelled, or terminated for any reason.

#### Violation

 Any licensee who is found to have violated any provision of a plan or any order or regulation of the Board shall be liable to have his license suspended or canceled forthwith.

### Transfer of license

No dealer license may be the subject of a transfer to another person without the prior written approval of the Board.

#### Expiry

- 10.(1) All licenses shall expire on the 31st day of July in each year.
  - (2) Notwithstanding subsection 10(1), licenses for the 2004/05 marketing season shall expire on August 14, 2005.

#### Renewal

11. Any dealer who is in arrears with the Board with respect to any levies shall, in addition to any other penalty therefor, not be entitled to a renewal of any license required by any licensing order in force from time to time until such time as all arrears of levies are paid to the Board.

#### Details of sale to be furnished to Board

12.(1) All dealers shall, within a period of twenty-four hours of finalizing a sale of potatoes from the Province of Prince Edward Island, be required to furnish the Board with the name of the buyer; the destination for such shipment; the quantity and size of package; the price; and the mode of transportation, and shall be required before making such shipment to obtain a transportation number from the Board and furnish to the Board the invoice covering such shipment within a period of thirty days from the date of shipment.

(2) Each shipment referred to in subsection 12.(1) shall be evidenced by separate invoice, and no invoices purporting to cover more than one shipment shall be accepted by the Board as compliance with the requirements of subsection 12.(1).

Unsatisfied judgments 13. (1) In the event an unsatisfied judgment is registered against an applicant for a dealer's license, or against any other entity owned or controlled by such applicant which previously held a dealer's license issued by the Board, the Board shall be entitled to refuse to issue a dealer's license to such applicant until all such judgments are paid and satisfied. In addition, it shall be a term and condition of each dealer's license issued by the Board that, in the event that any judgment be registered against a licensed dealer in Prince Edward Island and remain unsatisfied for a period greater than seven days, the license of such dealer shall be liable to suspension or cancellation at the discretion of the Board.

Conflicting information

(2) In the event that information relating to sale of Prince Edward Island potatoes provided by a dealer to the Board orally, in order to obtain a Board transportation order number, varies from information contained in the invoice respecting such sale forwarded to the Board, the Board may, at its discretion, withhold the issuance of further Board transportation order numbers to such dealer until such time as the dealer has an explanation acceptable to the Board for such variance.

Failure to provide invoices (3) In the event that a dealer declines or fails to provide to the Board a copy of the invoice in respect to any sale of Prince Edward Island potatoes within thirty days of receipt by such dealer of a Board transportation order number in respect to such sale, the Board may, in its discretion, withhold the issuance of further Board transportation order numbers to such dealer until such time as the dealer has made an explanation acceptable to the Board for the refusal or failure to provide such invoice in the time stipulated.

Power to withhold

- (4) The Board hereby delegates to such of its employees who, in the ordinary course of their duties as employees of the Board issue Board transportation order numbers, the power to withhold Board transportation order numbers for the reasons and in the manner set out in subsections 13.(2) and (3).
- 14. Board Order PB04-2 is hereby revoked.

Commencement

15. This order comes into force on the 26 day of July, 2005.

#### EC2005-437

### PRINCE EDWARD ISLAND LANDS PROTECTION ACT **EXEMPTION REGULATIONS AMENDMENT**

(Approved by His Honour the Lieutenant Governor in Council dated 2 August 2005.)

Pursuant to clause 17(1)(b) of the Prince Edward Island Lands Protection Act R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. L-5, Council made the following regulations:

### 1. The Prince Edward Island Lands Protection Act Exemption Regulations (EC368/88) are amended by the addition of the following after section 1:

**1.1** (1) For the purposes of this section,

Definitions

- (a) "approved cooperative venture" means a cooperative venture that approved is approved by the Lieutenant Governor in Council under subsection cooperative venture
- (b) "arms length" means the relationship of persons who

arms length

- (i) do not hold shares in more than one corporate member of the cooperative venture, or
- (ii) are not related to each other by kinship or marriage;
- (c) "cooperative venture" means a corporation that is incorporated cooperative venture solely for the purpose of operating a facility or infrastructure in the primary resource sector, for the benefit of its shareholders or members;

(d) "material change" means a change in the corporate structure or material change membership of a cooperative venture that affects any ownership interest that is greater than 5 percent.

(2) An approved cooperative venture is exempt from clause 2(b) and Exempt class of section 5 of the Act in respect of the specific landholdings identified in corporations the approval granted under subsection (6).

(3) A corporation may apply to the Lieutenant Governor in Council for Application approval as a cooperative venture by filing an application in the form approved by the Commission.

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(4) The Commission shall

Commission applications

- (a) review all applications made under subsection (3);
- (b) obtain information pertinent to the application; and
- (c) make recommendations to the Lieutenant Governor in Council on the disposition of the application.

Further information

(5) An applicant shall provide such further information as may be required by the Commission or the Lieutenant Governor in Council upon a review of any application under this section.

Approval

- (6) The Lieutenant Governor in Council may issue an approval to an applicant if the Lieutenant Governor in Council is satisfied that
  - (a) the applicant is a cooperative venture;
  - (b) the land holding held by the applicant is not, or will not be. greater than that necessary to provide a site for the facility and necessary infrastructure to operate the facility;
  - (c) the shareholders of the applicant are independent and at arms length from each other and have a common interest in owning and operating the facility or infrastructure;
  - (d) the application is not made solely for the purpose of raising capital or procuring investments for the applicant; and
  - (e) the applicant will comply with the conditions set out in subsection (7).

Conditions

- (7) An approval under subsection (6) shall be subject to the following conditions:
  - (a) the cooperative venture shall not change the use of the facility or the land specified in the approval after the approval is issued:
  - (b) the cooperative venture shall not subdivide the land specified in the approval;
  - (c) subject to subsection (10), no material changes shall be made in the shareholdings of the cooperative venture after the issuance of the approval; and
  - (d) such other conditions as the Lieutenant Governor in Council may impose.

Approval to specify nature of venture and lands

(8) The Lieutenant Governor in Council shall specify in an approval issued under subsection (6), the nature of the cooperative venture and the lands to which the approval applies.

Amendment of approval

(9) At least 30 days before any proposed material change in the shareholdings of an approved cooperative venture, an approved cooperative venture shall apply to the Lieutenant Governor in Council for an amendment of the approval granted under subsection (6) by filing an application with the Commission in the form approved by the Commission.

Amendment of approval

(10) The Lieutenant Governor in Council may amend the approval of an approved cooperative venture, if the Lieutenant Governor in Council is satisfied that the approved cooperative venture will continue to meet the provisions of subsections (6) and (7), and such other conditions as the Lieutenant Governor in Council may require.

(11) If the Lieutenant Governor in Council determines that an approved cooperative venture has contravened any of the conditions imposed on the approval under subsection (7), the Lieutenant Governor in Council may rescind the approval by notice to the cooperative venture and to the Commission.

Approval may be rescinded

#### 2. These regulations come into force on August 13, 2005.

#### **EXPLANATORY NOTES**

**SECTION 1** establishes an exempt class of corporation which is made up of approved cooperative ventures, the procedures for issuing an approval and provides for the rescission of an approval.

**SECTION 2** is the commencement of these regulations.
