Electoral District Description

Connecting to the northeast extension of the Bear River Road and the Gulf of St. Lawrence and located to the north by the Gulf of St. Lawrence to St. John's Harbour. Bounded to the west by St. John's Harbour and the county line between Kings and Queens Counties to the south boundary line of Township lot 38, then east and north following the boundary line of Township lot 38 to the north boundary of Township lot 51, then easterly following the north boundaries of lots 51, 52, 53, 54 and an easement shown to the east. Boundaries of Township lot 55 then westerly along the east boundary of Township lot 55 to Route # 314, then following Route # 314 and Branch # 312, crossing Route # 310 to the west branch of Little River to Home Bay and an extension of the Bear River Road to Kelly Bay. Bounded to the east by the westerly extension of the Bear River Road then westerly along the extension and the Bear River Road and a northwesterly extension of the Bear River Road to the Gulf of St. Lawrence to the point of commencement.
