NOW KNOW YE that We, by and with the advice and consent of our Executive Council for Prince Edward Island, do by this Our Proclamation ORDER AND DECLARE that the said Act being "An Act to Amend the Environmental Protection Act and the Island Regulatory and Appeals Commission Act" passed in the fifty-fourth year of Our Reign shall come into force on the thirteenth day of September, two thousand and five of which all persons concerned are to take notice and govern themselves accordingly.
