CHAPTER I-9

INTERPROVINCIAL SUBPOENA ACT

WITNESS FEES AND TRAVELLING EXPENSES REGULATIONS

Pursuant to section 9 of the Interprovincial Subpoena Act R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. I-9, Council made the following regulations:

- 1. For the purposes of the Interprovincial Subpoena Act R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Witness fees Cap. I-9 the following witness fees are prescribed:
 - (a) \$100 per day for an ordinary witness;
 - (b) \$300 per day for an expert or professional witness. (EC395/87)
- 2. For the purposes of the said Act the following travelling and living Travelling and expenses are prescribed:

living expenses

Actual, reasonable travelling expenses incurred in relation to attendance in court together with actual, reasonable living expenses, including accommodation, meals, local transport and sundry expenses. (EC395/87)
