CHAPTER L-17

LOTTERIES COMMISSION ACT

PROVINCIAL SUPER-LOTO REGULATIONS

Made by the Lieutenant Governor in Council under the *Lotteries Commission Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. L-17

1. (1) The Atlantic Lottery Corporation is responsible for the purchase, distribution and sale of tickets in, and the conduct and operation in the province of, the lottery scheme known as “The Provincial Super-Loto” in accordance with the terms of the agreements made between the Prince Edward Island Lotteries Commission and the Interprovincial Lotteries Corporation. Responsibility for Provincial Super-Loto

(2) The regulations of the Interprovincial Lotteries Corporation apply to the conduct and operation of the lottery scheme mentioned in subsection (1). Application of regulations

(3) For the avoidance of doubt it is declared that the Atlantic Lottery Corporation Regulations do not apply to the lottery scheme mentioned in subsection (1). (EC1077/78) *Idem*
