CHAPTER P-14

POULTRY AND POULTRY PRODUCTS ACT

QUARANTINE REGULATIONS

Made by the Lieutenant Governor in Council under the *Poultry and Poultry Products Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. P-14

- 1.** Every person intending to import live poultry or used poultry equipment from outside the Province of Prince Edward Island must inform the Prince Edward Island Department of Agriculture and Forestry of his intention to do so at least ten days prior to the arrival thereof in the province. (Jan 17/52, 300/80; 115/84; 639/93)

Notice of importation of poultry
- 2.** (1) All live poultry and used poultry equipment imported into the province must be shipped or transported directly to the purchaser's premises.

Transportation

(2) The said purchaser's premises will be placed under quarantine for a period to be determined by the Director of Veterinary Services for Prince Edward Island. (Jan 17/52)

Quarantine
- 3.** (1) During such period when said premises are under quarantine, no person shall ship or transport birds, either live or dead, from the premises.

Restrictions during quarantine

(2) During such period of quarantine no person shall ship or transport eggs from said premises for use in hatching.

Idem

(3) Eggs intended for the commercial market may be shipped or transported from such premises during such period. (Jan 17/52)

- 4.** Every person who engages in the shipment or transportation into the province of live poultry or eggs for hatching purposes shall secure a license from the Department of Agriculture and Forestry of Prince Edward Island. (Jan 17/52, 300/80; 115/84; 639/93)
