## CHAPTER P-24

### PROVINCIAL BUILDING CODE ACT

#### THERMAL INSULATION REGULATIONS

Made by the Lieutenant Governor in Council under the *Provincial Building Code Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. P-24

**1.** This regulation applies to the thermal insulation of all new residential buildings intended for use on a continuing basis. (EC550/76) Application

**2.** Thermal insulation of all new residential buildings intended for use on a continuing basis shall be as follows: Insulation requirement for new residential buildings

- (a) thermal insulation in all ceilings shall have an R value of 20;
- (b) thermal insulation in all walls shall have an R value of 10.
