CHAPTER R-13.02
RETAIL BUSINESS HOLIDAYS ACT
EXEMPTION REGULATIONS

Pursuant to section 7 of the *Retail Business Holidays Act* R.S.P.E.I. Cap. R-13.02 Council made the following regulations:

1. All craft fairs are exempt from the application of section 2 of the Act. Change of status
(EC554/93)
2. Subject to regulations made under the *Liquor Control Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. L-14 tourism related businesses of a tourism operator who has paid all requisite charges under the *Tourism Industry Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. T-3.3 are exempt from the application of section 2 of the Act. Exemption
(EC375/94).
3. (1) Harness racing and pari-mutuel betting at the Summerside Raceway on May 14, 2006, May 21, 2006, May 28, 2006 and June 4, 2006 are exempt from the application of section 2 of the Act. Racing, betting exemption
- (2) Harness racing and pari-mutuel betting at the Charlottetown Driving Park on August 13, 2006 and October 8, 2006 are exempt from the application of section 2 of the Act. *Idem*
