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**CHAPTER S-9**  
**SUMMARY PROCEEDINGS ACT**  
**TICKET REGULATIONS**

Pursuant to section 10 of the *Summary Proceedings Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. S-9, Council made the following regulations:

- 1.** For the purposes of section 10 of the Act, the form of the ticket shall be as set out in Schedule 1 to these regulations. (EC321/01) Form of ticket
- 2.** For the purposes of section 10 of the Act the offences under the provisions of the enactments set out in Schedule 2 to these regulations are designated as offences in respect of which a ticket may be issued. (EC321/01) Designated offences
- 3.** (1) The words or expressions set out in column 1 of Schedule 2 may be used on a ticket to designate an offence under the provision of the enactment referred to in column 2 thereof. Words and expressions describing offence

(2) Notwithstanding subsection (1), any words or expressions used on a ticket which describe with sufficient clarity the offence committed shall be for all purposes a sufficient description of an offence designated in Schedule 2. (EC321/01) *Idem*
- 4.** Where there appears in respect of an offence described in column 1 of Schedule 2, under a provision of an enactment referred to in Column 2 thereof, an amount in Column 3 thereof setting out a specified penalty for out-of-court settlement in respect of that offence, the issuing officer may enter on the ticket the specified penalty and the total of the specified penalty and the surcharge prescribed under subsection 9(2) of the *Victims of Crime Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. V-3.1, and where such an endorsement is made the provision of section 11 of the *Summary Proceedings Act* have effect. (EC321/01) Penalty for out of court settlement
- 5.** The *Summary Proceedings Act* Ticket Regulations (EC1174/81) are revoked. (EC321/01) Revocation
