## **CHAPTER W-7.1**

## WORKERS COMPENSATION ACT

## APPEAL REGULATIONS

Pursuant to section 80 of the Workers Compensation Act R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. W-7.1, Council approved the following regulations made by the Workers Compensation Board of Prince Edward Island:

1. An appeal shall be commenced by filing with the Workers Filing of appeal Compensation Appeal Tribunal, c/o Workers Compensation Board of Prince Edward Island, 14 Weymouth Street, P.O. Box 757, Charlottetown, P.E.I., C1A 7L7, within 30 days of the decision by the Workers Compensation Board, five copies of a written notice of appeal which includes the following information:

(a) the name, address, telephone number and claim or employment number of the appellant;

(b) the date of the decision being appealed;

(c) the grounds of appeal and relief requested. (EC357/95;493/04)

**2.** Within 30 days after filing the notice of appeal, the appellant shall file Appellant's with the Workers Compensation Appeal Tribunal five copies of any materials and submissions, arguments or reasons upon which the appellant intends to rely at the hearing of the appeal. (EC357/95)

3. The Workers Compensation Appeal Tribunal will distribute filings as Distribution of appropriate and as received to the Workers Compensation Board, the appellant and all other parties who have a direct interest in the matter. (EC357/95)

4. Within 30 days after receiving the materials, submissions, arguments Respondent's materials or reasons of the appellant, the Workers Compensation Board and all other parties who have a direct interest in the matter and who choose to be involved in the appeal, shall file with the Workers Compensation Appeal Tribunal five copies of the materials, submissions, arguments or reasons upon which they intend to rely. (EC357/95)

5. The filing of an appeal does not operate as a stay of proceedings under Effect of filing the decision appealed. (EC357/95)

6. On application by a party, the Workers Compensation Appeal Extension of time Tribunal may by order extend any time prescribed by these regulations on such terms as are just. (EC357/95)
