## **CHAPTER W-7.1**

## WORKERS COMPENSATION ACT

## SPOUSAL BENEFITS REGULATIONS

Pursuant to section 80 of the Workers Compensation Act R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. W-7.1, Council approved the following regulations made by the Workers Compensation Board of Prince Edward Island:

1. Where, pursuant to subsection 38(1) of the Workers Compensation Act Spousal benefits R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. W-7.1 or its predecessor Act, a surviving spouse in receipt of spousal benefits lost the right to the spousal benefits upon remarriage prior to April 17, 1985, the surviving spouse shall have the benefits reinstated, without interest, from April 17, 1985 to January 1, 1998, by way of a lump sum payment reflecting the amounts payable during that period.
