CHAPTER T-3.01

TIME UNIFORMITY ACT

- 1. Subject to section 2, there shall be one uniform, official time in use throughout the province which shall be Atlantic Standard Time. 1995,c.41,s.1
- 2. In each year between 2:00 a.m. on the first Sunday in April and 2:00 Daylight saving a.m. on the last Sunday in October. Daylight Saving Time, being one hour in advance of Atlantic Standard Time, shall be observed throughout the province. 1995,c.41,s.2.
