CHAPTER T-7

TRUCK OPERATORS' REMUNERATION ACT

1. The Lieutenant Governor in Council may make regulations fixing standard or minimum rates of remuneration to be paid for the hire of trucks, truck drivers and trucking service in connection with any class or operators classes of contract or work to be carried out in the province, and prescribing penalties enforceable against any person violating the regulations. R.S.P.E.I. 1974, Cap. T-8, s.1.
