The mission of the Health and Social Services System is to promote, protect, and improve the health and independence of Islanders.

The system's goals are:

- to improve the health status of Islanders
- to increase our acceptance of the responsibility for our own health
- to improve the sustainability of the system
- to increase public confidence in the system
- to improve workplace wellness and staff morale
- to maintain other results at current levels

The Health and Social Services System consists of the Minister, the Deputy Minister, the Department of Health and Social Services, and the five health authorities including the four health regions (West Prince Health, East Prince Health, Queens Health, Kings Health), and the Provincial Health Services Authority.

Departmental staff provide advice, assistance and information to the health authorities. The health authorities deliver health and social services to the region for which they are responsible.

Home Care services are provided to individuals based on assessed need, and are intended to:

- help individuals achieve and/or maintain health and personal independence in the community; and
- supplement the care and support available from family and friends

Programs offered by Home Care and Support include: Home Care Nursing, Home Dialysis Program, Visiting Homemakers, Community Support Services, Occupational Therapy, Physiotherapy, and Adult Protection.


Disability Support Program

<u>Canada Mortgage and Housing Corporation</u> (CMHC):

Home Adaptations for Seniors Independence (HASI)

This Program helps homeowners and landlords pay for minor home adaptations to extend the time lowincome seniors can live in their own homes independently.

Who is Eligible?

Homeowners and landlords may qualify for assistance as long as the occupant of the dwelling where the adaptations will be made meets the following eligibility criteria:

- is 65 and over;
- has difficulty with daily living activities brought on by ageing;
- total household income is at or below a specified limit for your area;
- dwelling unit is a permanent residence.

At age 65, everyone who meets Canada's citizenship and legal resident requirements is entitled to an Old Age Security Pension.

The **Guaranteed Income Supplement** is an additional monthly benefit available to seniors who receive Old Age Security (OAS) and have low to modest income.
