

A New Look for Prince Edward Island Driver Licences...

The driver's licence and non-driver's licence are the most widely accepted documents for identification in the nation today. Because these documents are so important, the Prince Edward Island Department of Transportation and Public Works wants you to know about the design and new security of the licences.

Card Formats Issued as:

- Adult & Under The Age of 19 Driver Licence
- Learner's Driver Licence
- Graduated Driver Licence
- Restricted Driver Licence
- Identification Card

Beginning in the fall of 2006, all Access PEI branch offices will be issuing driver's licences utilizing a new design and format.

The new design and format incorporates all the standards for driver's licences as agreed to in the Canadian Drivers Licence Agreement. (CDLA). These are elements of the North American security framework, which were developed by the Canadian Council of Motor Transport Administrators (CCMTA) and its US sister organization, the American Association of Motor Vehicle Administrators (AAMVA). The security elements comprise the verification process, card specifications and fraudulent document recognition training as well as establishing legal presence and authorized length of stay.

A state-of-the-art computer imaging network is making the process possible. This system retrieves basic data about the applicant from the existing database, digitizes the applicant's photo and signature, then produces a tamperresistant document all within minutes.


The new licences are designed with new security features making them virtually impossible to alter or counterfeit without detection.

Greater Security and Benefits

- Portrait and signature are both digital and stored in a permanent database for easy retrieval in order to verify identification.
- The "Under 19" driver licences and identification cards are now issued in a new format that is immediately recognizable. Under 19 cards display the words "UNDER 19 UNTIL/PAS 19 ANS AVANT" followed by the date the cardholder will turn 19 in bold yellow text. This text is positioned vertically next to the portrait.
- Other security patterns on the front of the card are visible only under ultraviolet light.
- The digitized image is stored in a database for easy retrieval in order to verify identification.
- There is a 1 dimensional and a 2 dimensional barcode, micro-printing, as well as several other new security features.
- Licences are bilingual, English/French.
- Organ donors will be identified with a red heart on the lower right-hand side of the card.
