How it works

The BMTA provides financial assistance to women business owners who wish to undertake business management training in such areas as:

- Marketing
- Human Resources
- Business Operations
- Finance and Accounting
- Information Management
- · Pursuing Broader Opportunities for Business Growth

What does this mean to you?

The Business Management Training Allowance will finance up to 75% (to a maximum of \$2,000) of approved training costs.

Who is eligible?

To be eligible, the business must be owned by a woman or women who:

- Own at least 50% of the business;
- Have at least 51% of its operating control;
- Are involved in the day-to-day running of the business.

All industry sectors are eligible.
