5.1 Application

5.1.1 This section applies to every non-pleasure craft (excluding multihulls, inflatable craft, vessels carrying cargo over 1000 kg, and vessels built or converted for towing, dredging or lifting) exceeding 6 m (19 ft 8 in) in length, the keel of which was laid or the construction or manufacture or fibreglass lay-up of which was started on or after April 1, 2005.
