This publication has been prepared for use and guidance of Canadian airline operators operating, or seeking authority to operate, two-engine aeroplanes more than 60 minutes at single engine cruise speed, from an adequate airport on routes that are not wholly within Canadian Domestic Airspace.

This ETOPS document will be amended as engineering data and practical operational experience dictate. Policy and terms of reference in this publication supersede previous directives.
