Budesonide Inhalation Solution (Pulmicort Nebuamp®)

Under the Family Health Benefit and Financial Assistance Programs, all strengths of budesonide inhalation solution (Pulmicort Nebuamp®) are limited to children under 6 years of age.

Coverage for children under 6 years of age does not require an Exceptional Drug Request. However, pharmacies must contact the Drug Programs Office at 368-4947 (Charlottetown) or 1-877-577-3737 (toll-free) to have budesonide inhalation solution authorized for patients. Once obtained, authorization to fill prescriptions for budesonide inhalation solution remains in place until the child turns 6 years of age.

Coverage for budesonide inhalation solution is not provided for persons over 6 years of age as the medical literature shows their asthma can be effectively managed using either a dry powder inhaler (e.g. Flovent Diskus® or Pulmicort Turbuhaler®) or a metered-dose inhaler (e.g. Flovent®) in combination with a holding chamber (e.g. Aerochamber® or Pocket Chamber®).
