# MEMORANDUM D15-2-17

## BICYCLES AND FRAMES

This Memorandum refers to the application of anti-dumping duty to importations of certain bicycles and frames thereof, originating in or exported from Chinese Taipei (formerly designated as Taiwan) and the People's Republic of China, pursuant to section 3 of the *Special Import Measures Act* (SIMA), as a result of an order continuing a finding of injury by the Canadian International Trade Tribunal (CITT).

## GUIDELINES AND GENERAL INFORMATION

1. The subject goods are defined as follows:
  - (a) bicycles, assembled or unassembled, with wheel diameters of 16 inches (40.64 cm) and greater, originating in or exported from Chinese Taipei and the People's Republic of China, excluding bicycles with an FOB Chinese Taipei and People's Republic of China selling price exceeding CAN\$225 and folding bikes; and
  - (b) bicycle frames originating in or exported from Chinese Taipei and the People's Republic of China, excluding bicycle frames with an FOB Chinese Taipei and People's Republic of China selling price exceeding CAN\$50.

4. The liability for duty results from proceedings conducted under the *Special Import Measures Act* and from an order continuing a finding of injury by the CITT.
