Report your exports electronically

Looking for a fast, easy way to report your exports? There are two options for reporting your exports electronically.

What are they?

Canadian Automated Export Declaration (CAED)

CAED is a Windows based software package downloaded from the Statistics Canada Web site. CAED provides exporters or their agents with the ability to transmit completed Export Declarations directly to the Government of Canada via the Internet.

G7 Electronic Data Interchange (EDI) **Export Reporting**

G7 EDI Export Reporting is an EDIFACT based protocol that allows exporters to either transmit export declarations directly to the Canada Border Services Agency (CBSA) or through the use of a service provider. Exporters must complete testing with the CBSA prior to being approved for production.
