Moving Firewood?

You could be transporting quarantine pests.

The movement of firewood from pest-regulated areas of Canada is strictly controlled. Firewood is known for carrying **insects** and **plant diseases** that could spread to other uninfested areas of Canada.

If you move firewood, possibly when camping, relocating or managing a wood lot, you could be transporting one of the following quarantine pests:

- Brown Spruce Longhorn Beetle
- Dutch Elm Disease
- European Larch Canker
- Gypsy Moth
- Pine Shoot Beetle

What can you do to stop the spread of quarantine pests in Canada?
