SECTION III - HEALTH CERTIFICATION

I, the undersigned full-time salaried official veterinarian of the Government of Canada hereby certify that after due enquiry and to the best of my knowledge and belief, the animals described below comply with the following requirements:

1. The animals were born and raised in Canada.
2. Canada is free from foot and mouth disease, rinderpest and contagious caprine pleuropneumonia, brucellosis, vesicular stomatitis, ovine or caprine smallpox, Rift Valley fever, Nairobi fever, trypanosomiasis, heart water, Wesselborn's disease, peste des petits ruminants and Akabane disease.
3. The farm of origin of the animals has had no clinical or laboratory evidence of scrapie within the previous five (5) years.
4. The farm of origin and surroundings have had no occurrences of the following diseases within the previous one hundred and twenty (120) days: enzootic abortion, brucellosis, paratuberculosis, vibriosis, malignant catarrhal fever, contagious ecthyma, bluetongue, contagious agalactia, Jaagsietke (pulmonary adenomatosis), caprine arthritis encephalitis, Maedi Visna, scrapie, listeriosis, and psoroptes ovis.
5. The animals have remained in isolation for thirty (30) days before export and the farms of origin and adjacent farms have not been under quarantine due to transmissible diseases affecting sheep.
6. While in isolation, the animals have been treated for internal and external parasites within the fifteen (15) days prior to departure with a product effective against Hepatic and Pulmonary endoparasites.

7. While in isolation, the animals were subjected to the following tests with negative results within thirty (30) days of departure:

- i) tuberculosis - intradermal test using bovine PPD tuberculin;
- ii) paratuberculosis - CFT or ELISA;
- iii) caprine arthritis encephalitis/Maedi Visna - agar gel immunodiffusion test or ELISA.
