

**VETERINARY HEALTH CERTIFICATE

I, the undersigned Official Veterinarian of the Canadian Food Inspection Agency (CFIA), duly authorized by the Government of Canada, hereby certify that, after due enquiry and to the best of my knowledge and belief, the sheep and/or goats described below meet the following requirements:

1. Canada is free from foot-and-mouth disease, rinderpest, peste de petits ruminants, vesicular stomatitis, bluetongue, brucellosis and Rift Valley Fever and has been free for the twenty-four (24) months period preceding the departure.
2. As far as it has been possible to ascertain, scrapie has not existed on the premises of origin of the animals during the three (3) years immediately prior to the date of departure and the animals are not the progeny of a sire or dam which has been affected by scrapie.
3. The animals for export to Guyana were examined, found physically sound and in good health and free of symptoms of scrapie and other infectious and contagious diseases.
4. During the period of twenty (20) days immediately prior to the date of departure, the animals were tested for the following diseases with negative results:
 - i) brucellosis - BPAT
5. The animals were treated against internal and external parasites with approved products within seventy-two (72) hours of departure.
6. The animals were given an intramuscular injection, at recommended dosage, of penicillin-streptomycin combination or any other broad spectrum antibiotic on each of the two (2) days preceding departure.
7. The animals were transported in vehicles which were previously cleaned and disinfected to the point of embarkation without coming into contact with individuals of the same or other species that are subject to diseases of ovines except those of equal health status.
