The ratites described below and the flocks of origin have been inspected and as a result of a careful examination, no evidence of Newcastle disease or any communicable disease of poultry was found nor, insofar as it has been possible to determine, were the ratites exposed to any such disease during the ninety (90) days immediately prior to the inspection date. Newcastle disease, fowl plague or highly pathogenic avian influenza has not occurred on the premises of origin, nor on any adjoining premises during the ninety (90) day period preceding exportation and the area where the premises is located has not been under quarantine for any avian disease during the preceding ninety (90) days.

Ratites (other than those exported for immediate slaughter), are of Canadian origin and have been determined, upon careful examination, to be free of ticks and other ectoparasites.
