I, the undersigned Veterinarian, duly authorized by the Government of Canada, do hereby certify that:

1. Canada is free from rinderpest, contagious bovine pleuropneumonia, ephemeral fever, lumpy skin disease, foot and mouth disease and vesicular stomatitis.
2. The donor stags have been resident in the herd or origin for the two (2) years preceding collection of the semen.
3. The premises of origin of the donor animal is recognized to be free of tuberculosis and brucellosis and has passed complete negative herd tests of all eligible animals for both brucellosis and tuberculosis according to Canadian disease control standards .
