# **PROGRAM OVERVIEW**

#### **PROGRAM DESCRIPTION**

The <u>purpose</u> of the Northern Scientific Training Program (NSTP) is to support Canadian universities in providing training that gives advanced and graduate students the opportunity to gain professional experience in the Canadian North and encourages them to develop a commitment to northern work. The Program objective is to increase the number of graduate and other advanced students within Canadian universities who have specialized in some aspects of northern studies and who have northern research experience.

The Program achieves its objectives by encouraging the formation of multi-disciplinary focal points for northern studies within Canadian universities and providing <u>supplementary financial assistance</u> to universities for students to help offset the high cost of specialized studies in the North. This assistance covers costs attributable to a northern research project which involves supervised field experience in the Canadian North. The NSTP also considers applications from students interested in undertaking research in other circumpolar countries (i.e. Greenland, Norway, Sweden, Finland, Russia and Alaska). It is an assistance program and because of its limited funds it cannot provide employment for students or on-going support in the form of general scholarships. NSTP funds must be used to defray transportation costs, living expenses, freight costs and interpreter fees encountered when carrying out the fieldwork portion of their research projects.

#### **PROGRAM ADMINISTRATION**

The NSTP is managed by the Department of Indian Affairs and Northern Development. An intergovernmental committee is responsible for reviewing the applications and ensuring the effective use of funds provided to the universities by the Program. The participating universities are responsible for disbursing the funds to awarded to assist advanced students in gaining supervised northern experience and training in the North.

The NSTP Committee makes major Program policy decisions and all granting decisions. The members are appointed by the Deputy Minister of Indian Affairs and Northern Development. Participating universities are invited to help set direction for the Program at the annual meeting of the Association of Canadian Universities for Northern Studies (ACUNS), during visits to individual universities by the Program Secretariat, and on other occasions. This process facilitates annual Program refinements in response to changing needs and evolving circumstances.

## **REPORT ON 2003-2004 ACTIVITIES**

#### PROGRAM UPDATE

Funding to participating Canadian universities under the Indian and Northern Affairs Canada (INAC) Northern Scientific Training Program (NSTP) will increase to \$1 million per year, beginning in the fall of 2004. This increase will allow Canadian students of northern science and researchers alike to better contribute to the pool of knowledge about the North, and capitalize on international research results.

#### **PROGRAM ACTIVITIES**

In addition to on-going administrative tasks, including refinements to the Program Guidelines and the preparation of the Annual Report and Bibliography, the following points highlight the major activities coordinated by the Program Secretariat during 2003-2004.

#### NSTP Committee Membership

Presently, the NSTP Committee has 15 members, comprised of representatives from federal departments and agencies with an interest in northern scientific activities, the Government of Yukon and the Aurora and Nunavut Research Institutes. The Association of Canadian Universities for Northern Studies is represented as a non-voting member of the Committee and provides an additional linkage between universities and the NSTP. Appendix I lists the membership of the Northern Scientific Training Program Committee during 2003-2004.

#### NSTP/Northern Studies Promotion

During the past year, the Program Secretariat continued to collaborate with the Association of Canadian Universities for Northern Studies in promoting the vital and growing role of universities in northern research, and the role of the NSTP in support of university development of scientific expertise in the North.

#### Malcolm Ramsay Memorial Award

In order to honour Malcolm Ramsay's contribution to northern research, the NSTP Committee unanimously agreed to select a student project each year from the NSTP applications received for a Memorial Award.

Ken Cain, University of Alberta, was the recipient of the Malcolm Ramsay Memorial Award, for his project "*From theory to action: Understanding and implementing community-based research in Deline, NWT*" carried out in the 2003-2004 fiscal year. The Award consists of a \$1000 being added to the NSTP grant.

#### Annotated Bibliography of Publications Based on Research Supported by the NSTP

A bi-annual Bibliography of abstracts for publications of research projects conducted in 1999/2000 and 2001/2002 is currently in production. Bibliographical information submitted to the NSTP Secretariat for these research years has been integrated into the Arctic Institute of North America's Arctic Science and Technology Information System (ASTIS).

#### University Follow-Up

First, it is an established policy of this Program to provide each university with the specific comments arising from our Committee's assessment of applications under the NSTP. This on-going program follow-up with universities is achieved through correspondence, telephone contacts, and visits to individual universities by Program management.

In 2003-2004, the usual format for providing feedback to the universities through correspondence and telephone contacts was maintained with the purpose being to provide each northern studies committee or institute with the NSTP Committee's reaction to its application. Two university visits were conducted in 2003.

#### **OVERVIEW OF NSTP SUPPORT TO UNIVERSITIES DURING 2003-2004**

With respect to a statistical overview of the NSTP's 2003-2004 support to universities, the following briefly summarizes the information gleaned from reports by participating universities on their 2002 research year. The results are summarized in <u>Tables 1 through 7</u>, plus accompanying figures.

In 2002 a total of 30 universities listed in Appendix II undertook northern studies under this Program. The distribution of allocations under the Northern Scientific Training Program by university, 1962-63 to 2003-2004, found in <u>Table 1</u> and <u>Figure 1</u>, indicates that during its 42 years of existence the Program's contribution to university training in northern studies has totalled \$19,243,840.

University participation in the NSTP has generally increased over the years, except for the period spanning 1993 to 1997 where we saw a small decline in the number of universities applying for funds. But in the preceding years, the number of universities applying to the NSTP as well the amounts sought, have greatly increased resulting in universities receiving approximately half of the amount required to operationalise. This year 30 universities requested a total of \$1,306,944. in new NSTP funds and were awarded \$636,000.







In <u>Table 2 and Figures 2 and 2.1</u>, a general overview of the distribution of NSTP funds by university for the 2003-2004 research year is provided, revealing that a total of 273 students from 32 universities were supported. The average amount of funds allocated per student was \$2,408.88 with the students spending an average of 51.9 days in the North, at an average cost of \$46.39 per student/day in the North.



Northern Scientific Training funds were allocated toward defraying four types of support, as indicated in <u>Table 3 and Figure 3</u>. Student transportation expenditures predominated, followed by those for student living expenses, freight and interpreters.



The information contained in <u>Table 4 and Figure 4</u>, entailing the distribution of training funds by university and scientific field, reveals that projects in the life sciences predominated, representing 45.3 percent of the total, followed by the human sciences at 33.9 percent, and the physical sciences at 20.8 percent.







The distribution of NSTP supported students by university and scientific field, found in <u>Table 5 and Figure 5</u>, is analogous to the previous point in that students in the life sciences predominated at 120, followed by the human sciences at 96, and at 57 in the physical sciences.




With respect to the distribution of NSTP funds by university and geographic focus, <u>Table 6 and Figure 6</u> reveals that 29.6 percent of all projects were undertaken in Nunavut, N.W.T. at 19.1, Yukon at 16.2 percent, then in Northern Quebec at 13.4 percent, followed by northern provincial regions (except Québec) at 11.1, and finally in other circumpolar countries and Labrador at 6.4 and 4.2 percent respectively.

Finally, <u>Table 7 and Figure 7</u>, showing the distribution of NSTP supported students by university and academic level, reveal that the majority of students were in a Master's program (38.8 percent), followed by an undergraduate's program (35.2 percent) and doctoral program (26 percent).

#### 2004-2005 UNIVERSITY FUNDING REQUESTS

For 2004-2005, 30 universities and one northern college requested a total of \$1,673,535.16 in support of 394 students for an average allocation of \$4,247.55. <u>Table 8</u> provides the distribution of the final allocations under the Northern Scientific Training Program by university for 2004-2005, totalling \$1,000,000 for 31 institutions. The allocation of the training funds by the Northern Scientific Training Program Committee was made on the basis of an in-depth assessment of each application according to the following criteria:

- 1. extent to which the application fits with Program criteria;
- 2. evaluation of past performance and up-coming plans; and
- 3. the training component of the application and the contribution to the development of northern specialists at the university.

In addition, the Committee considered the number of students supported by the Program in the previous year, the number of students proposed for funding in the upcoming year, and the general completeness and clarity of the information provided in each application.
