Residency information for tax administration agreements

The Government of Canada has approved a tax sharing and administration agreement with the Thcho Government that will co-ordinate the *Thcho Income Tax Law* with the federal *Income Tax Act*.

All individuals, including non-Thcho citizens, who are resident on Thcho lands or in the Thcho communities of Behchokò (Rae-Edzo), Whatì (Lac La Martre), Gamètì (Rae Lakes), or Wekweètì (Snare Lake) have to identify themselves by ticking "Yes" in the Residency information for tax administration agreements box on page 1 of the 2005 Income Tax and Benefit Return.

The Canada Revenue Agency will use this information to administer the agreement.

Individuals, including Thcho citizens, who are not residents of Thcho lands or a Thcho community have to tick "No" in the Residency information for tax administration agreements box on page 1 of the 2005 Income Tax and Benefit Return.
