## Information about Children's Special Allowances (CSA)

CSA are non-taxable amounts paid monthly to an agency that cares for a child under the age of 18 who resides in Canada. A child is considered to be cared for by an agency if, at the end of the month, the child is dependent on it for his or her care, maintenance, education, training, and advancement to a greater extent than any other agency or individual.

The term **agency** applies to:

- federal, provincial, and territorial departments;
- agencies appointed by a province or territory for the protection and care of children;
- · group foster homes and institutions; and
- institutions licensed or otherwise approved by a province or territory to have the custody and care of children.

If the agency does not have a Business Number, it must provide proof (original or certified copy) that it is licensed or approved to have the custody or care of children.

Upon approval, CSA payments will start the month after the month that the child starts to be cared for by the agency and all of the eligibility conditions have been met.

We **only** make retroactive payments for a period of up to 11 months preceding the month we receive the application, and will be based on the amount payable for the month to which the retroactive payment applies.

We usually make CSA payments to the agency that cares for the child. However, payments may be paid directly to a foster parent at the agency's request. In this situation, complete the "Foster parent information" section below.

The monthly amount payable for each child is equal to the maximum basic amount of the Canada Child Tax Benefit (CCTB) plus the National Child Benefit Supplement and the proposed Child Disability Benefit supplement (if eligible).

We will stop paying the CSA automatically when the child turns 18.
