## Sending electronic T4 slips by email to your employees

You can now provide T4 slips to your employees in an electronic format. **After you receive their written consent** in a letter or by email, you can send a single copy of the slip by email on or before the **last day of February.** The employee's written consent has to be kept in your files.

### CCRA secures carbon-loaded slips for small employers

We are securing carbon-loaded slips for **small employers.** If you still use carbon-loaded slips because:

- you will file a very small number of slips (10 slips or less); or
- you will fill them out by hand,

# Failure to file a large information return in an electronic format

In the years 2000, 2001 and 2002, employers that did not comply with this regulation only received warning letters from the CCRA. Starting in April 2003, failure to comply with this regulation will result in a penalty being assessed.

Therefore, if you file more than 500 various information slips (e.g. T4, T4A, T5) and you do not file the information returns in an electronic format as required under the *Income Tax Act* and *Income Tax Regulations*, you may be guilty of an offence. Beginning January 1, 2004, the Canada Customs and Revenue Agency will release *Tables on Diskette (TOD)* as a Java application.

The look and functionality of TOD will not change. However, TOD will be reproduced on a compact disc instead of a diskette and Macintosh users will now be able to use TOD to calculate their payroll deductions.
