T4 Internet filing

In January 2005, an enhanced T4 Internet filing service will be available. The T4 Webforms and the File Transfer applications will accept either original or amended T4 returns for filing. The number of slips that can be filed with the File Transfer option will be increased to 499 slips (610 kilobytes). For more information, visit our Web site at www.cra.gc.ca/T4internet.

Reporting of fisher's income on T4 slips

For the 2004 and 2005 tax years, you can report fisher's income on either a T4F slip or a T4 slip.

However, starting in January 2007, fisher's income must be reported on a T4 slip, as we will no longer produce or accept the T4F slip or T4F summary. For more information, see the publication called *Filing the T4 Slip and Summary Form* (RC4120).

Canadian forces personnel and police deduction

Under proposed changes, a deduction from taxable income can be claimed for the amount of employment earnings (including taxable allowance) of Canadian forces personnel and police who are deployed outside Canada on a high-risk or current moderate-risk operational mission.
