

# Attention ATV Owners



The law and regulations that control how and where you use your ATV '**(a) "all terrain vehicle" means a wheeled or tracked motor vehicle designed for travel primarily on unprepared surfaces such as open country and marshland**' are important. They help to keep you safe. Under the Off-Highway Vehicle Act, it is illegal to operate an ATV on any highway within the Province of Prince Edward Island, with the exception of crossing a road. It is also against the law, to operate an ATV on the Confederation Trail.

**Remember, ATV's are intended for OFF-HIGHWAY use only.**
