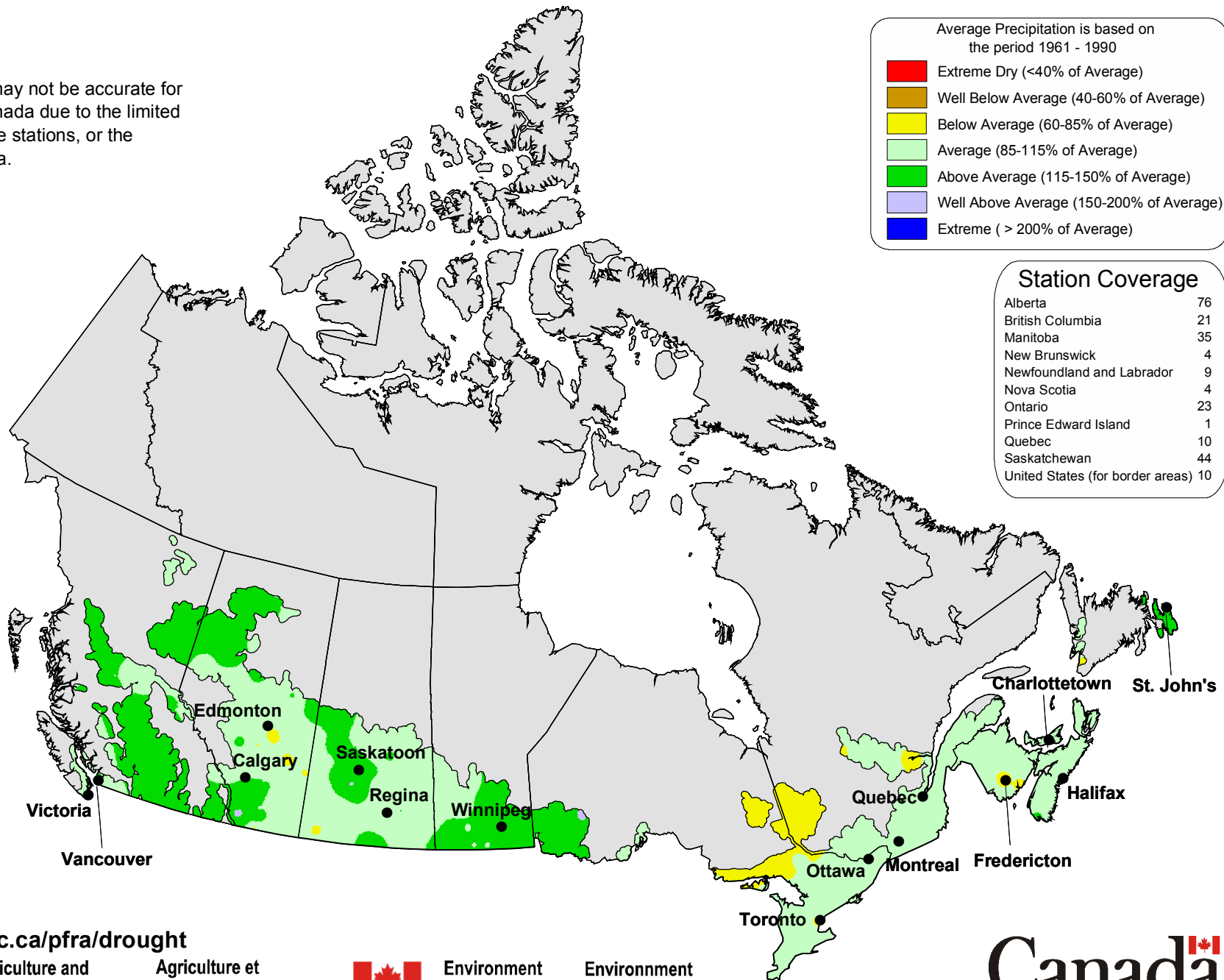


# Percent of Average Precipitation in Agricultural Areas

September 1, 2004 to August 10, 2005 (AM)

This illustration may not be accurate for all regions of Canada due to the limited number of climate stations, or the availability of data.



Average Precipitation is based on the period 1961 - 1990

- Extreme Dry (<40% of Average)
- Well Below Average (40-60% of Average)
- Below Average (60-85% of Average)
- Average (85-115% of Average)
- Above Average (115-150% of Average)
- Well Above Average (150-200% of Average)
- Extreme (> 200% of Average)
