## **AIDE ACCORDÉE EN ALBERTA, 1997-1998**

---

- En 1997-1998, le Conseil des Arts du Canada a accordé 5,5 millions de dollars aux arts en Alberta. Ce montant inclut 860 000 \$ accordés aux artistes et organismes artistiques avec les nouveaux fonds reçus par le Conseil.
- Un montant de 367 000 \$ a en outre été payé à 578 écrivains et écrivaines de l'Alberta dans le cadre du Programme du droit de prêt public<sup>1</sup>, ce qui porte à 5,8 millions de dollars l'aide attribuée en Alberta.
- Le Conseil a accordé 804 000 \$ en subventions à 80 artistes de l'Alberta et 4,7 millions de dollars à 87 organismes artistiques de l'Alberta<sup>2</sup>.
- L'aide du Conseil a touché toutes les disciplines - danse, musique, théâtre, arts visuels, arts médiatiques, lettres et édition et art interdisciplinaire. Le plus gros pourcentage de l'aide est allé au théâtre et à la musique (1,6 millions de dollars dans chaque discipline), puis aux arts visuels (834 000 \$) et aux lettres et à l'édition (578 000 \$).
- Des subventions de 2,3 millions de dollars ont été accordées aux artistes et organismes artistiques d'Edmonton, ce qui représente 41 p. 100 de l'aide à la province. Calgary a reçu 2,5 millions de dollars (46 p. 100 du total). Les autres collectivités de l'Alberta ont reçu 682 000 \$ (13 p. 100 du total).
- 38 artistes et professionnels des arts ont été engagés comme membres de jurys, évaluateurs et conseillers, ce qui représente 6,3 p. 100 de tous les membres de jurys auxquels le Conseil fait appel.
- Les artistes et organismes artistiques de l'Alberta ont reçu 5,9 p. 100 des subventions du Conseil des Arts du Canada. La province représente 8,6 p. 100 du personnel professionnel et technique des arts et 9,3 p. 100 de la population.
- Selon le Recensement de 1996, la province de l'Alberta compte 27 080 personnel professionnel et technique des arts<sup>3</sup>, ce qui représente une augmentation de 12 p. 100 par rapport à 1991.
