of All Forms of Discrimination against Women Part I Article 1 For the purposes of the sion or restriction made on the basis of sex which has the effect or purpose of impairing or nullif a basis of **equality** of **men** and **women**, of human rights and fundamental freedoms in the political, ec on against women in all its forms, agree to pursue by all appropriate means and without delay a property of the contract of th the principle of the equality of men and women in their national constitutions or other appropriate le eans, the practical realization of this principle; (b) To adopt appropriate legislative and other measures, in stablish legal protection of the rights of **women** on an **equal** basis with **men** and to ensure through cor ainst any act of discrimination; (d) To refrain from engaging in any act or practice of discrimination against his obligation; (e) To take all appropriate measures to eliminate discrimination against **women** by any to modify or abolish existing laws, regulations, customs and practices which constitute discrimination <mark>ainst **women**. Article 3 States Parties shall take in all fields, in particular in the political, social, econo</mark> pment and advancement of **women** , for the purpose of guaranteeing them the exercise and enjoy Adoption by States Parties of temporary special measures aimed at accelerating de facto **equality** k ention, but shall in no way entail as a consequence the maintenance of unequal or separate standard <mark>atment have been ac</mark>hieved. 2.
