

1.	The semen was derived from a boar standing a supervision of a veterinary surgeon approved by				
2.	The donor boar is not known to be affected with, or vaccinated against, foot and mouth disease, swine fever, swine vesicular disease (SVD), brucellosis, transmissible gastroenteritis (TGE), Aujeszky's disease, or porcine reproductive and respiratory syndrome (PRRS).				
3.	During the six (6) months prior to the collection of the semen, no case of swine vesicular disease or transmissible gastroenteritis has occurred at the A.I. Centre.				
4.	During the twelve (12) months immediately preceding the collection of semen, the pigs at the A.I. Centre showed no clinical evidence of tuberculosis, brucellosis, leptospirosis, Aujeszky's disease, teschen disease, rabies, or PRRS.				
5.	Insofar as can be determined, since entering the semen production centre, the donor boar has not been in direct or indirect contact with animals affected with, or vaccinated against, foot and mouth disease, classical swine fever (hog cholera), African swine fever, SVD, TGE, Aujeszky's disease (pseudorabies), brucellosis, or PRRS.
