

- 6. The donor ram described above and all other animals maintained at the semen production centre were subjected to testing for the following diseases with negative results within the six (6) months preceding collection of the semen:
 - a) tuberculosis intradermal test with bovine PPD tuberculin;
 - b) brucellosis BPAT or CF test for B. abortus and CF for B. ovis;
 - c) leptospirosis agglutination lysis test for L. pomona and L. sejroe;
 - d) paratuberculosis agar gel immunodiffusion test or ELISA test;
 - e) maedi-visna agar gel immunodiffusion or ELISA test
- 7. All health tests referred to in this certificate were conducted by Veterinary Officers of the Canadian Food Inspection Agency and all diagnostic tests were performed at approved laboratories.
