- 8. Canada is recognized to be officially free of foot and mouth disease, rinderpest, contagious bovine pleuropneumonia, vesicular stomatitis and brucellosis in the domestic cattle population.
- 9. The donor bull is clinically healthy and exhibits no evidence of BSE at the time of collection;
- 10. The semen to be exported was continuously stored in an approved semen production centre from the time of its collection until its dispatch to the United States.
