

3.1 Entry and Maintenance Testing

The donors were examined and tested for various diseas during the isolation period and at intervals whilst resident testing standards and Regulations applying to Al centres

4. SEMEN COLLECTION, PROCESSING AND STORAGE

- 4.1 The collection and processing of semen for this consignment was done in accordance with the Canadian Health of Animals Regulations, Section 15 (Artificial Insemination) of Disease Control Manual of Procedures and the recommendations of the OIE Code Appendix 3.2.1, articles 3.2.1.8 and 3.2.1.9.
- 4.2 Following collection and examination, the semen was placed in straws indelibly marked with the identification details of the donor and the date of collection or a code from which this information could be determined.

5. **SHIPMENT**

- 5.1 Under the supervision of an Official Veterinarian, the semen straws were identified and placed into new, unused liquid nitrogen in a new or properly disinfected container for export.
- 5.2 The container was sealed and the number or mark on the seal recorded on the certificate prior to export.
