PART B - GOVERNMENT VETERINARY CERTIFICATE

I, _____ (BLOCK LETTERS), being an official veterinarian of the Canadian Food Inspection Agency, hereby certify in respect of the semen being exported that:

- 1. After due enquiry I have no reason to doubt the truth of the Veterinary Surgeon's Certificate at Part A.
