I, the undersigned Official Veterinarian, duly authorized by the Government of Canada, do hereby certify that:

- 1. Canada is free from rinderpest, contagious pleuropneumonia, lumpy skin disease, foot and mouth disease, African swine fever, classical swine fever, enzootic porcine encephalomyelitis (Teschen's disease), pseudorabies and brucellosis.
- 2. The semen production centre is officially approved by central veterinary authorities and is officially free of tuberculosis, brucellosis, leptospirosis, pseudorabies and transmissible gastroenteritis as per the Canadian porcine artificial insemination program.
- 3. The semen production centre is under veterinary supervision.
- 4. The semen production centre is situated in an area of 30 km of diameter where foot and mouth disease, classical swine fever and African swine fever have not occurred during the last 12 months.
- All the boars in the centre have been clinically free in the last 12 months of brucellosis, enzootic porcine encephalomyelitis (Teschen's disease), leptopsirosis, Aujeszky's disease and porcine reproductive and respiratory syndrome (PRRS).
- 6. The semen for export was derived from boars tested for the following diseases with negative results:
 - 6.1. within 12 months of the date of collection of the semen:
 - 6.1.1. brucellosis (B. Abortus, B. Suis): using a serological test;
 - 6.1.2. * parvovirus: using a serological test
 - * or the boars were vaccinated not later than 30 days before collection on: (yyyy-mm-dd)
 - 6.1.3 Aujeszky's disease: ELISA test.
 - 6.2 within 30 days of the date of collection of the semen:
 - 6.2.1 PRRS: ELISA test
- 7. The boars from which the semen was derived have been clinically healthy and physiologically normal at the time of the collection of the semen.
- 8. The exported semen was hygienically collected and packed for shipment.
