

## VETERINARY HEALTH CERTIFICATE EXPORT SWINE TO CAYMAN ISLANDS

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I, thee undersigned Veterinarian, duly authorized by the Canadian Food Inspection Agency (CFIA) do hereby certify that:

- 1. The animal(s) originate from herd(s) where no evidence of infectious disease has existed for at least thirty (30) days prior to shipment.
- 2. The herd(s) of origin are free of disease, based on herd history and clinical signs, especially in relation to Atrophic rhinitis, enzootic pneumonia, Aujeszky's disease, TGE, leptospirosis, Erysipelas, lasser's disease, brucellosis, tuberculosis and influenza.
- 3. Canada is free of hog cholera, foot-and-mouth disease, swine vesicular disease, African swine fever, Teschen disease, swine fever, brucellosis and Aujeszky's disease.
- 4. Within 30 days of export the animals for export were tested for the following diseases with negative results:
  - i) leptospirosis negative at 1:400 using the MAT for L. pomona, L. canicola, L. icterohaemorragiae, L. tarassovi, and L. grippotyphosa
  - ii) mycoplasmosis Canadian standards
  - iii) PRRS IFA
- 5. The animals originate from herds free of atrophic rhinitis based on clinical freedom and slaughter reports.
- 6. The animals were treated for ectoparasites including mange and lice using an approved parasiticide.
