Audit Recommendation (2001-642)	Proposed Action	Timeline
It is recommended that the Assistant Deputy Minister (ADM) Real Property Services (RPS) ensure that: appropriate mechanisms are in place to effectively monitor the implementation of the accessibility policy at the national and regional levels.	The national annual accessibility report will be reviewed and the required improvements made.	As this is an annual report, improvements will be incorporated over time, beginning in the next reporting cycle.
It is recommended that the ADM RPS ensure that: roles and responsibilities regarding the national and regional monitoring of the implementation of the accessibility policy are clarified to achieve agreement.	A Branch Office of Primary Interest (OPI) will be designated by the ADM, RPSB to deal with the issue of roles and responsibilities relating to monitoring of the accessibility policy.	The Branch OPI will be determined by the end of the first quarter, 2002/2003. Roles and responsibilities will be clarified by midyear.
