



FMD situation

The OIE has formally declared the eastern regions of Brazil FMD free with vaccination. These regions carry 116 million of Brazil's 164 million cattle.

In response to the FMD outbreaks, the US, Canada and other major importing countries have imposed strict measures on fresh and frozen beef from Argentina and Uruguay.

It is expected that the total beef exports for Argentina may decrease by 29% and for Uruguay by 32% from the USDA's previous forecast for the year 2001. Both countries are forced to deal with their excess supply; Uruguay's export dependence amounts to approximately 55% while Argentina's averaged about 13%.
