CHAPTER H-5

HIGHWAY TRAFFIC ACT

CONSTRUCTION (REFERENCE TO CONVICTION) REGULATIONS

Pursuant to section 299 of the *Highway Traffic Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. H-5, Council made the following regulations:

1. Any reference in the *Highway Traffic Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. H-5 or conviction regulations made thereunder to "conviction" shall be construed, in relation to a young person, to include a finding of guilt made by a youth court pursuant to the *Young Offenders Act* (Canada) R.S.C. 1985, Chap. Y-1 or the *Young Offenders* (*P.E.I.*) *Act* R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. Y-1. (EC128/86)
