During the recruiting process, your aptitude for a particular occupation is determined. You may choose a career in a field in which you already have some experience or the Army will teach you new skills.

**It's your choice -
full time or part time.**

If you choose full time in the Regular Force, you will initially sign a three year contract. Your length of service, as a part time volunteer in the Army Reserve, is completely up to you. Army Reservists generally work one evening a week and one weekend a month.

ELIGIBILITY

The basic joining requirements are:

Be a Canadian citizen

For the Regular Force, be at least 17 years old with parental/guardian consent

For the Reserve Force, be at least 16 years old with parental/guardian consent

Medically fit

Have a good record of conduct with no outstanding legal obligations

**Completion of grade 10
(Secondary III in Quebec)**
