Saint John CMA Highlights

Vacancy Rate on the Rise

Results of CMHC's 2002 Rental Market Survey revealed that there were increased vacancies in the Saint John metro area. Following a 5.6 per cent vacancy rate in the fall of 2001, the vacancy rate for apartment units rose to 6.3 per cent in October of this year.

The vacancy rate increased for all bedroom type. The popular two-bedroom apartment units had a 4.8 per cent vacancy rate, the lowest of all bedroom types. Vacancies dropped in West and East Saint John as well as in outlying areas and increased in the South and North areas of Saint John. Despite a slightly weaker demand for rental accommodation, the average rental rate for the Saint John CMA rose by nearly 3.5 per cent to \$475.

- Zone 4 Saint John East: Areas bounded by Route I on the north and Courtenay Bay on the west
- **Zone 5 Outlying areas:** Includes the towns of Rothesay, Quispamsis, Grand Bay-Westfield, Saint Martins Village and the Parishes of Greenwich, Kingston, Musquash, St. Martins, Simonds, Lepreau, Rothesay, Hampton and Simonds
