Vacancy Rates Higher in 2002

Data from Canada Mortgage and Housing Corporation's (CMHC) annual Rental Market Survey revealed higher vacancies in all three municipalities located in Muskoka. The Bracebridge vacancy rate increased from 0 per cent in 2001 to 1.8 per cent in 2002. In Gravenhurst, the vacancy rate increased from 2.8 per cent in 2001 to 3.2 per cent in 2002. Finally in Huntsville, the vacancy rate increased from 2.9 per cent in 2001 to 4.7 per cent in 2002. Overall for Muskoka, the vacancy rate increased from 1.9 per cent last year to 3.3 per cent in this year's survey. Low mortage rates have enabled some first time buyers to make the shift from rental to home ownership.

Rents in 2-bedroom apartments increased by 3 per cent last year and increased by an additional 3.9 percent in 2002. The rise in the vacancy rate from 1.9 per cent to 3.0 per cent for 2-bedroom units suggests that rent increases will moderate next year. Rent increases were strongest in Gravenhurst with the 2-bedroom rent increasing by 6.8 per cent to reach \$740.
