# Northern B.C. Rental Market Records Slight Improvement

- Although Northern B.C. rental markets remain in an oversupplied condition, markets such as Prince Rupert, Quesnel and Fort St. John experienced a significant drop in the overall apartment vacancy rate this year.
- The largest drop in apartment vacancies occurred in Fort St. John, with the overall apartment vacancy rate dropping to 8.4 per cent from 15.3 per cent last year. Fort St. John currently has the lowest vacancy rate of all the northern communities due to employment opportunities in the oil and gas sector in this region.
- Average apartment rents for all unit types have fallen in most Northern B.C. markets this year with the exception of slight rental rate increases in Kitimat, Prince Rupert, and Williams Lake. Since 1996, vacancy rates have risen dramatically in Williams Lake while the average apartment rent plummeted. The slight rental rate increase this year is a reaction to an overly dramatic rental rate drop in 1999.
- With the resource sector of B.C.'s economy continuing to languish, the mobile sector of the work force have sought brighter employment prospects in Alberta and other provinces. Renters are typically among this mobile group and as such, demand for rental accommodation has remained low due to a continuing outflow of inter provincial migrants from B.C.
